Writing

In writing we will practise our sentence writing. We will retell stories based on stories we know and fact files about animals. We will continue to practise our letter formation of lower case and capital letters.



Reading

In reading we will learn about scanning a text to find information. We will learn about the characteristics of fairy tales.

Music

In music we will learn about dynamics and tempo to perform a song.

Science

In science we will learn about different animals and how to identify them.

Maths

In maths we will focus on place value, counting, sorting and comparing amounts. We will learn number bonds to 10 and practise adding and subtraction.
