Writing

In writing we will practise our sentence writing and explore adjectives and verbs. We will refine the skills we learnt in Reception such as letter formation and full stops. We will write stories and poems.



Music

In music we will explore pulse and rhythm.

Reading

In reading we will learn about suffixes. We will learn how to scan a text for information. We will practise making predictions about stories.



Geography

In geography we will explore our local area and use maps.
