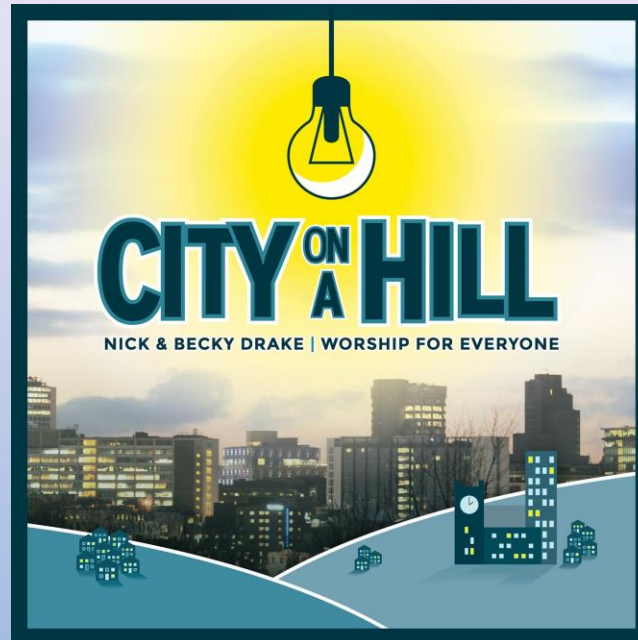
Dear Jesus,

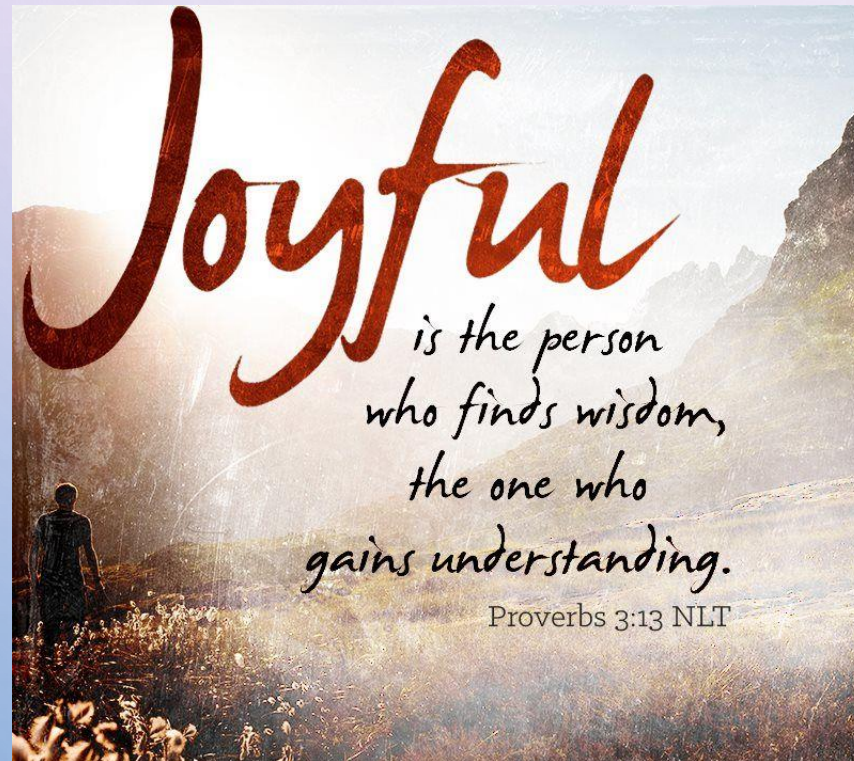

One of the books in the Bible is called Proverbs.

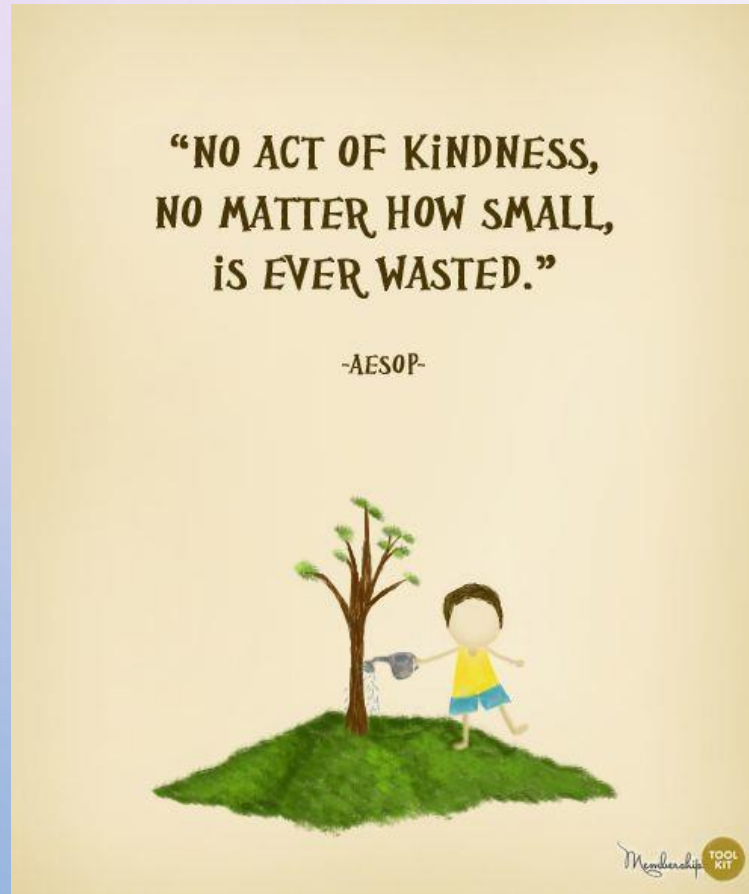
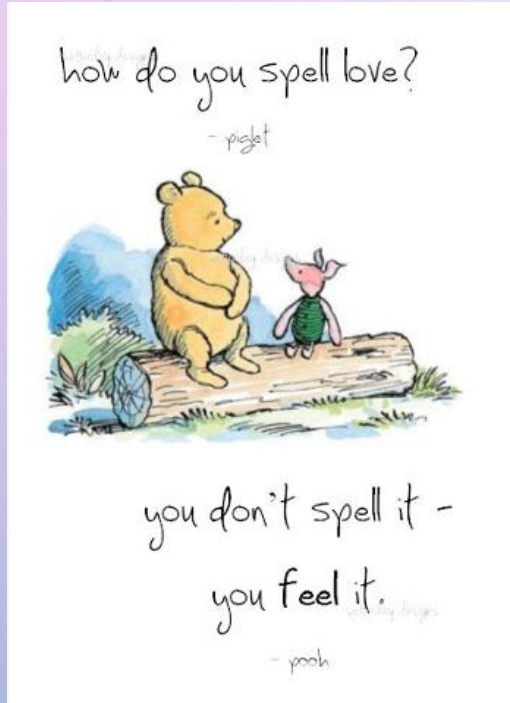
It was written by Solomon who was a really wise King.

What wise thing would you say to those coming into your class?

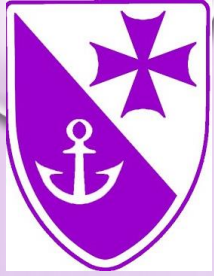
Teacher, you could write these down for those coming in September!
