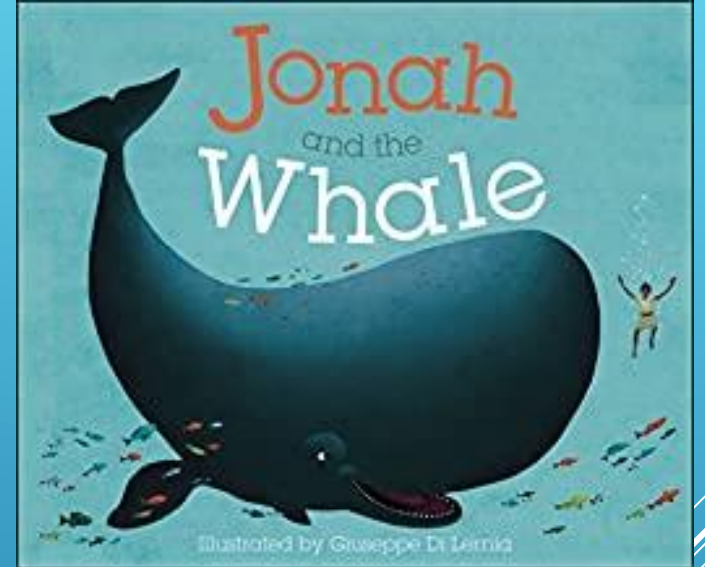

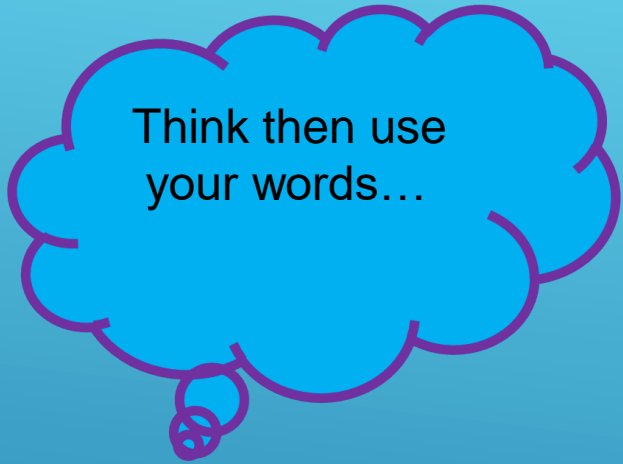


10 minute worship Monday 29th June

Jonah's job was to listen to God and tell people what to do.

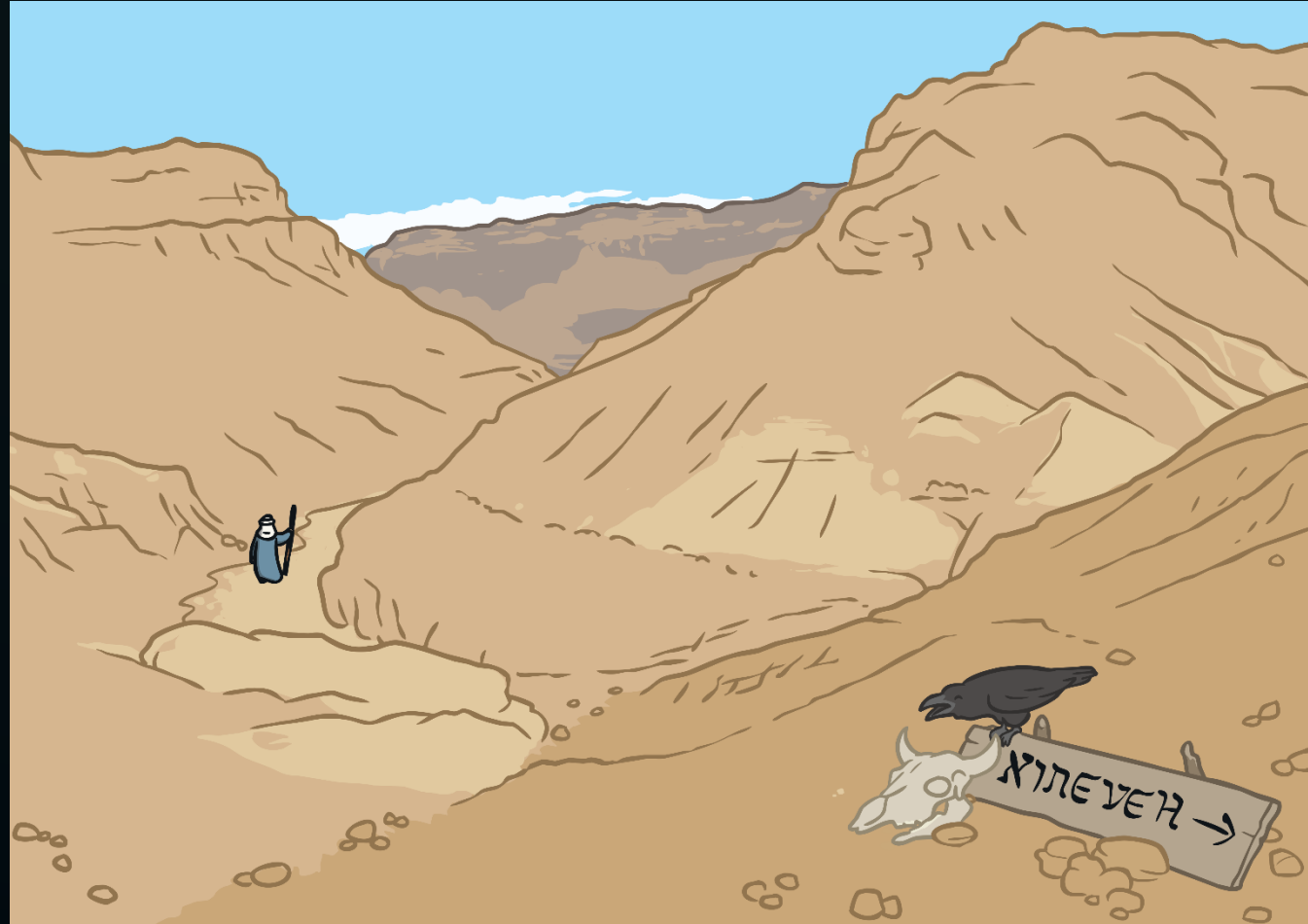
Thumbs up if you listen to your teacher and grown ups. Thumbs down if you do not.

sink.

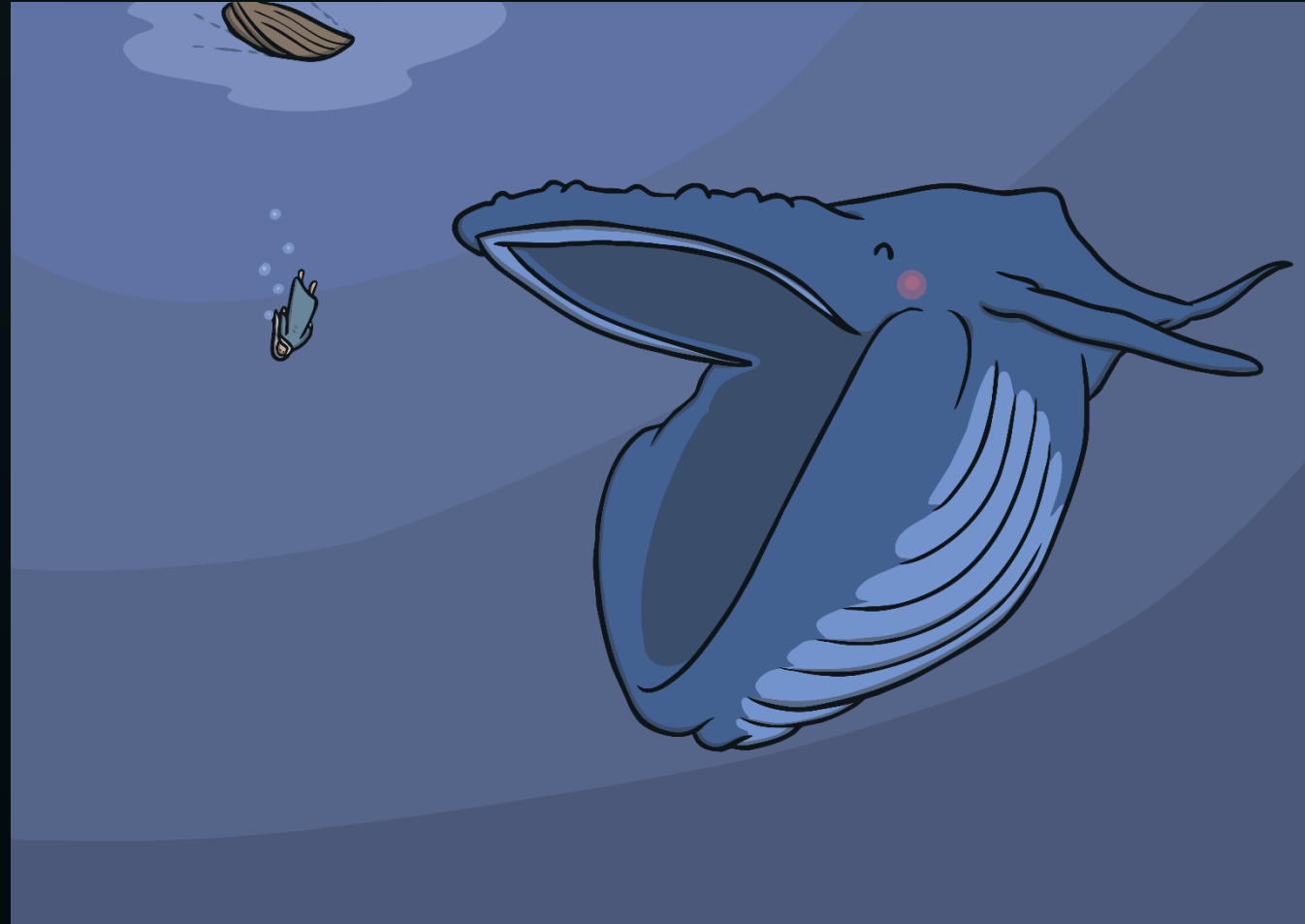


If you

Amen.

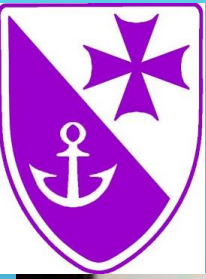




# Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July

But what do we really need to live? Things we could not be without?

Leader- Suggestions will be mainly material things (like food, water and medicines). Acknowledge these are very important, and to also think about things that cannot be seen but which are still important (like love, friendship, family, safety).



*You are rich, when you are  
content and happy with  
what you have.*

This means that it doesn't make us happy to have more and more stuff.

When we are thankful for what we have, we can be very happy.



This message is  
also in the Bible.  
It says

Be happy with  
what you have.

# FOOD WASTE



We know that we must take care of the earth, and not to use everything up – this is why we all recycle our waste.

Perhaps we could also think about using less. In our country, we can be very wasteful even with important things that people need to live, like food and water.

Did you know that 7 million tonnes of uneaten food is thrown out from our homes every year!

# WATER WASTE



Water is important too. And run or do you turn it off and on again just when you need it? In our country, we use 1050 litres of water per week, which is nearly 10 times more water than people living in Ethiopia in Africa use.

# WEMBLEY STADIUM



In just over one week, people in our country, the UK produce enough rubbish to fill Wembley stadium! Imagine this full of rubbish!!



# THE MOON

In one year, we make so much rubbish that it would fill dustbins reaching all the way from earth to the Moon.

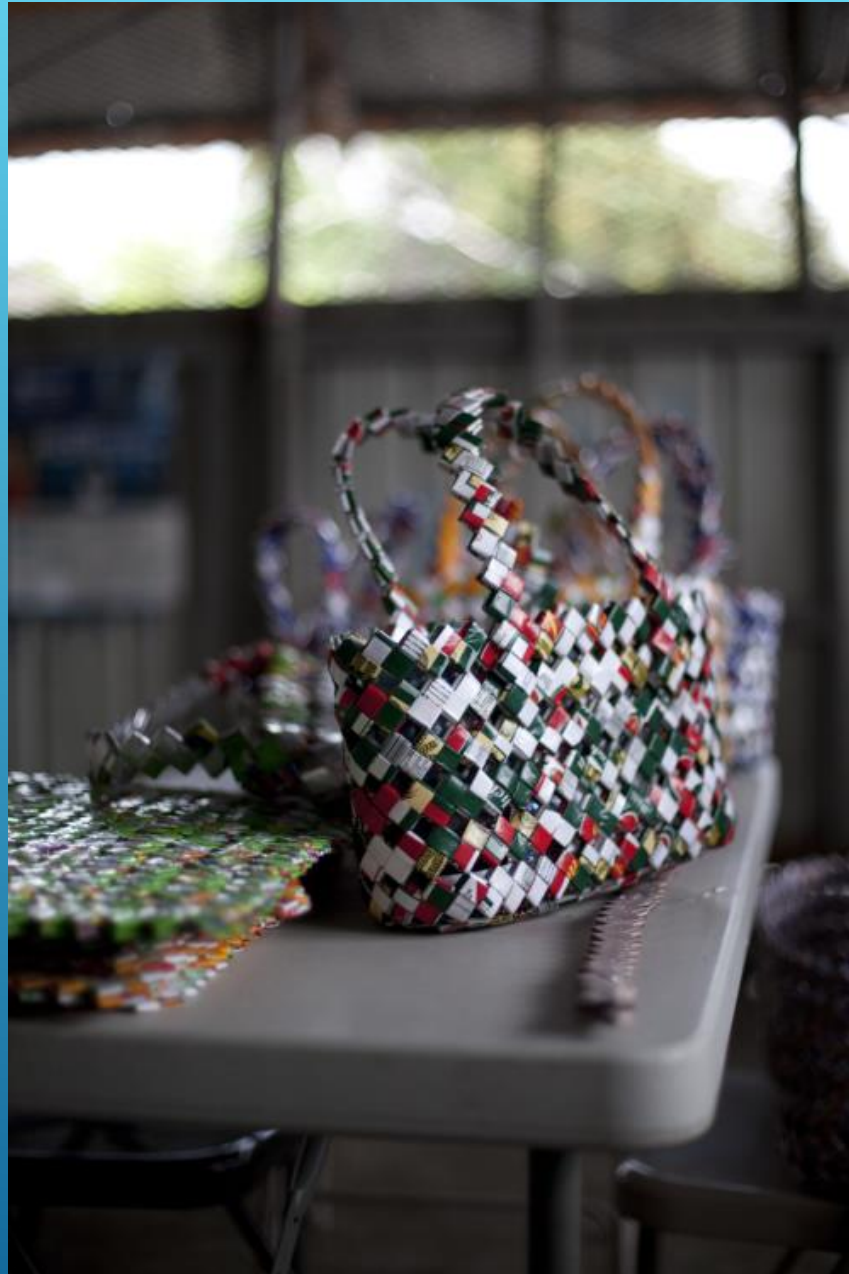
