Today we are going to be curious about telling the truth and telling lies.

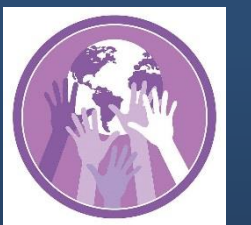
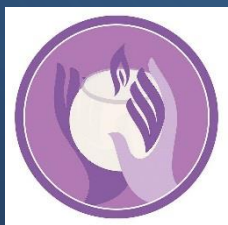

Listen carefully!

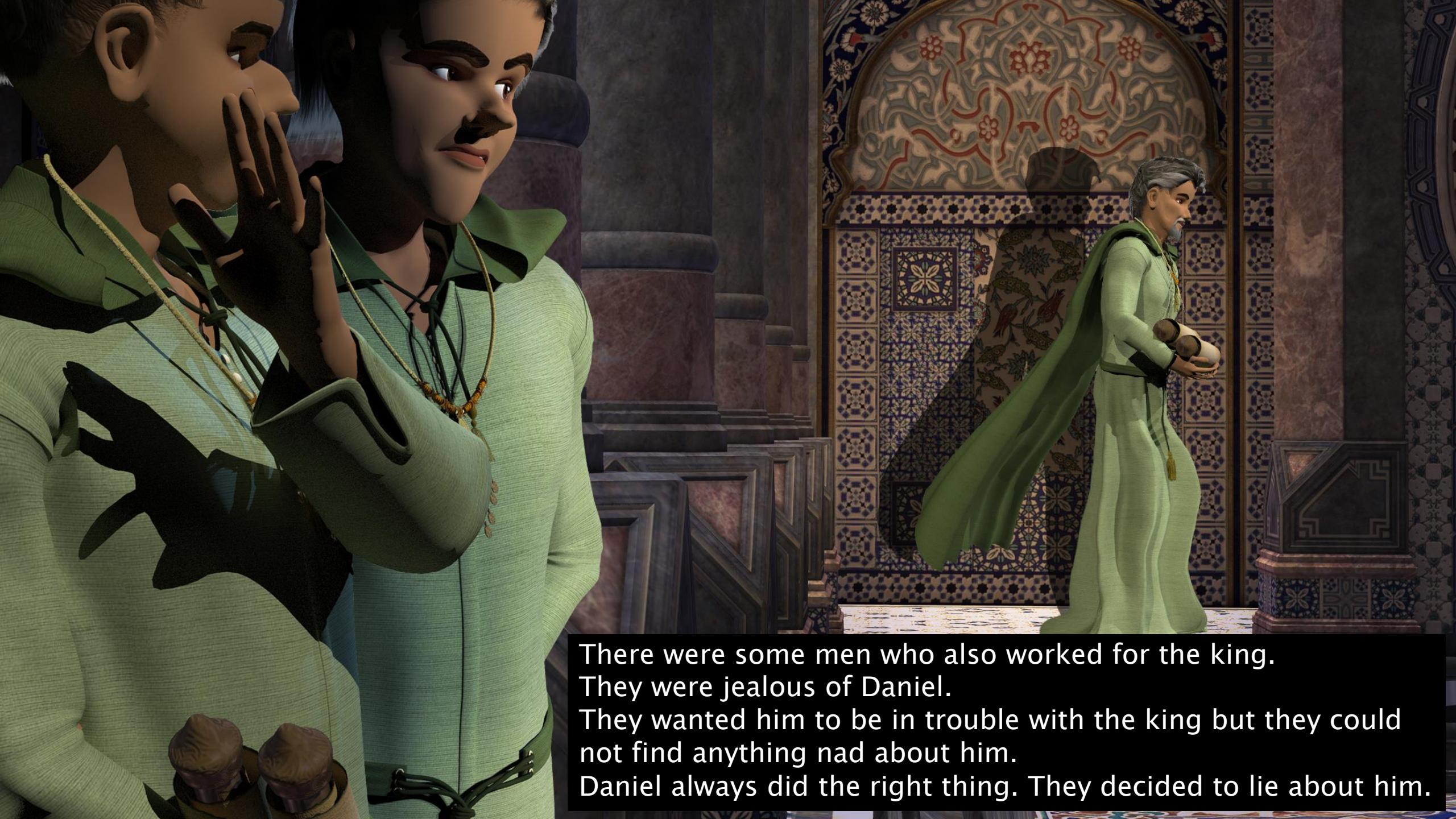


See if you can work out who told the lies and who told the truth in the story of Daniel and the Lions' den.



Daniel lived in a country far from his own home. He always worked very hard. The king noticed how hard Daniel worked. He made him the leader of his country.

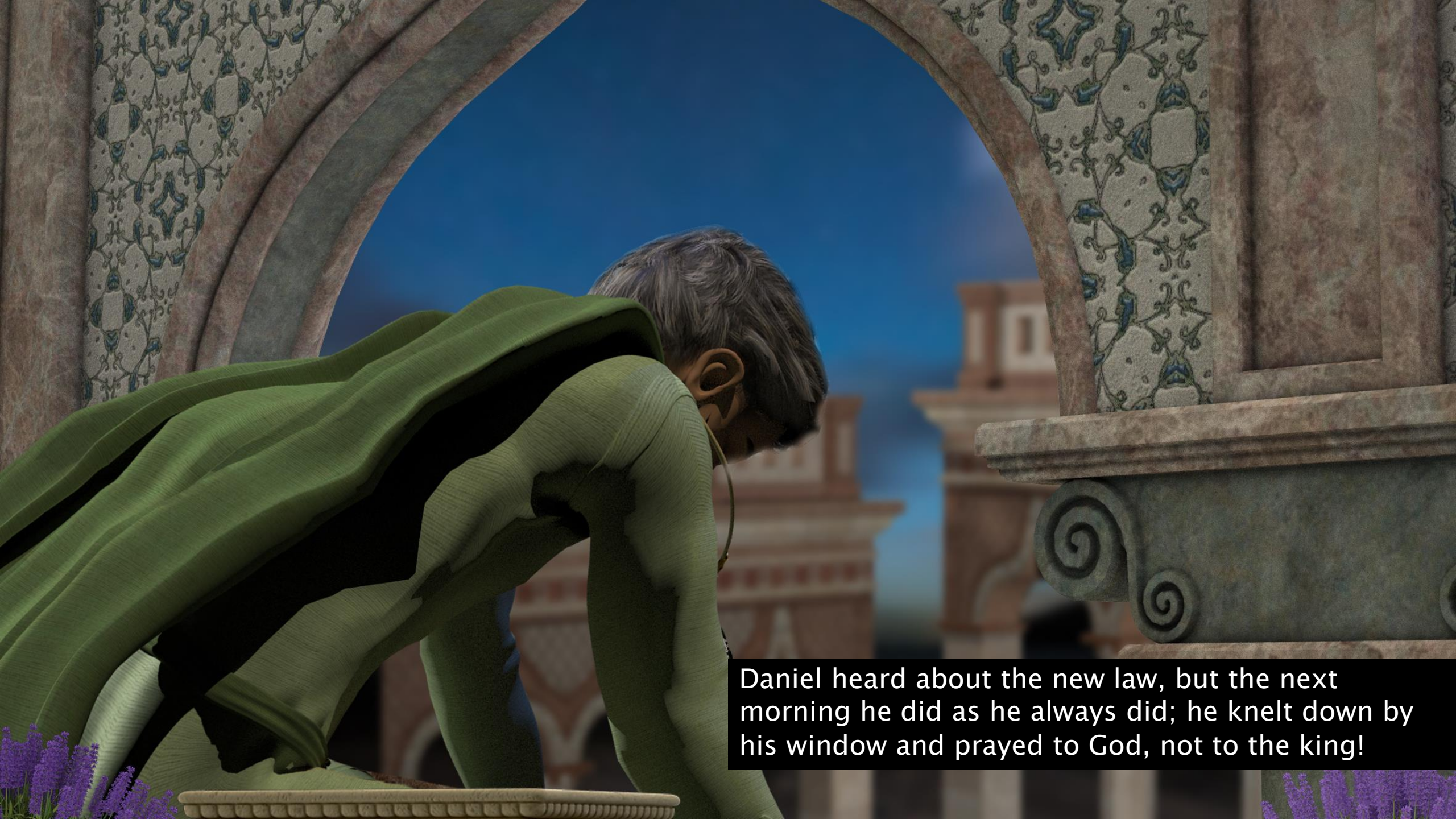




There were some men who also worked for the king. They were jealous of Daniel. They wanted him to be in trouble with the king but they could not find anything bad about him. Daniel always did the right thing. They decided to lie about him.

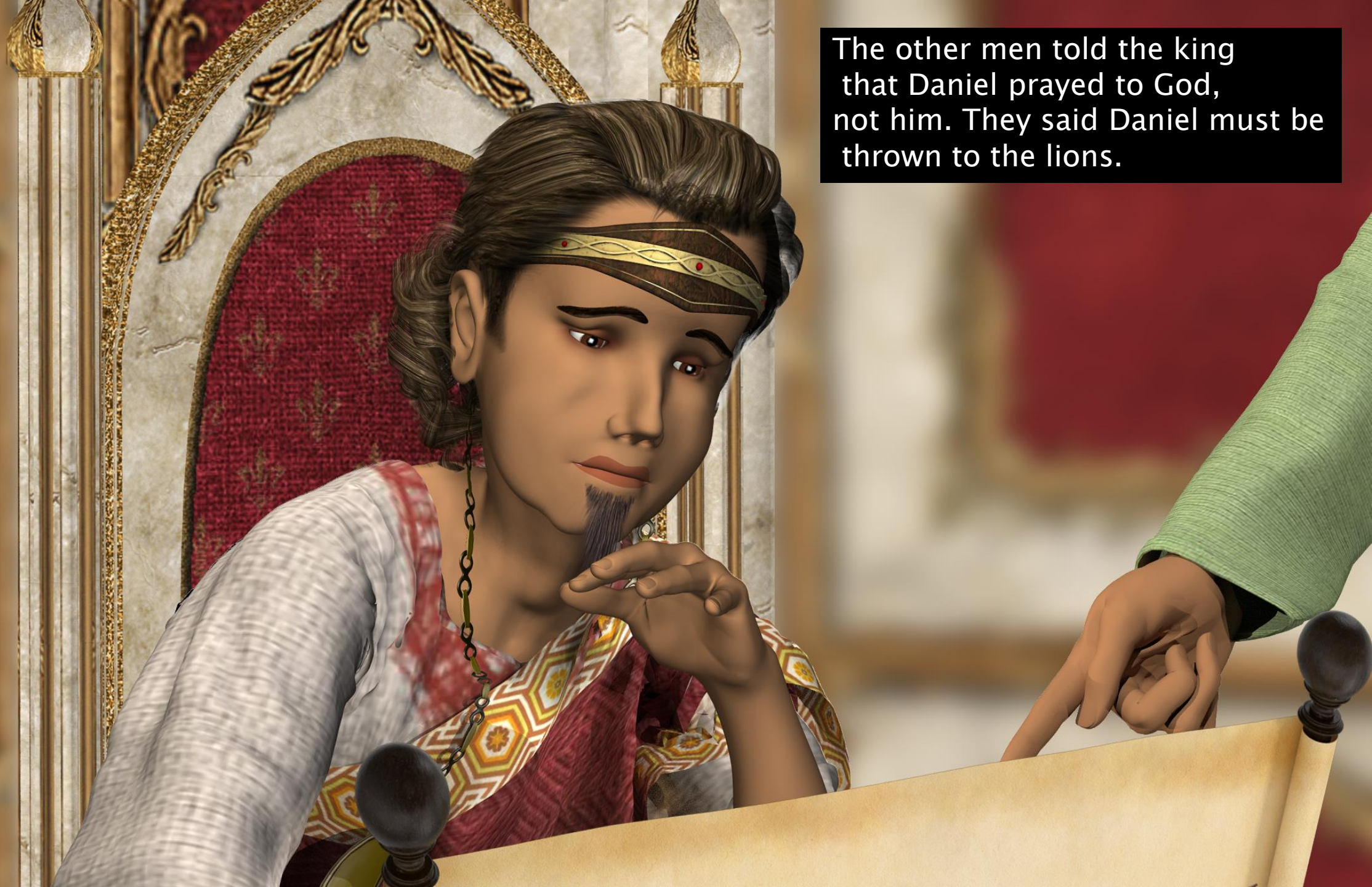


They went to see the king and asked him to make a rule. The rule said that everyone should worship the king, and only the king. Anyone who did not do this... would be thrown into the lions' den!



Daniel heard about the new law, but the next morning he did as he always did; he knelt down by his window and prayed to God, not to the king!

The other men told the king that Daniel prayed to God, not him. They said Daniel must be thrown to the lions.





The king was very sad because he liked Daniel, but he knew that he could not break his own law.



As Daniel was taken to the lions' den, the king whispered a little prayer – a prayer to Daniel's God, asking that Daniel might be saved from being eaten by the lions. .

Prayer

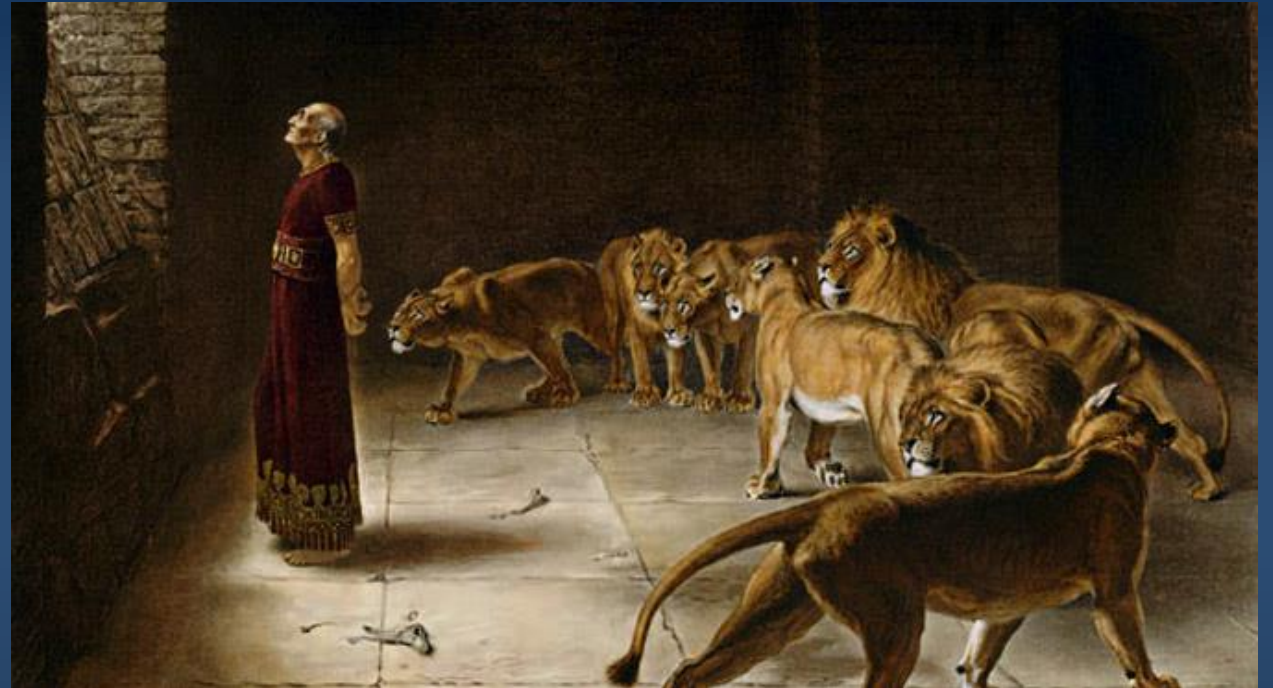
Dear Father God,

Amen.





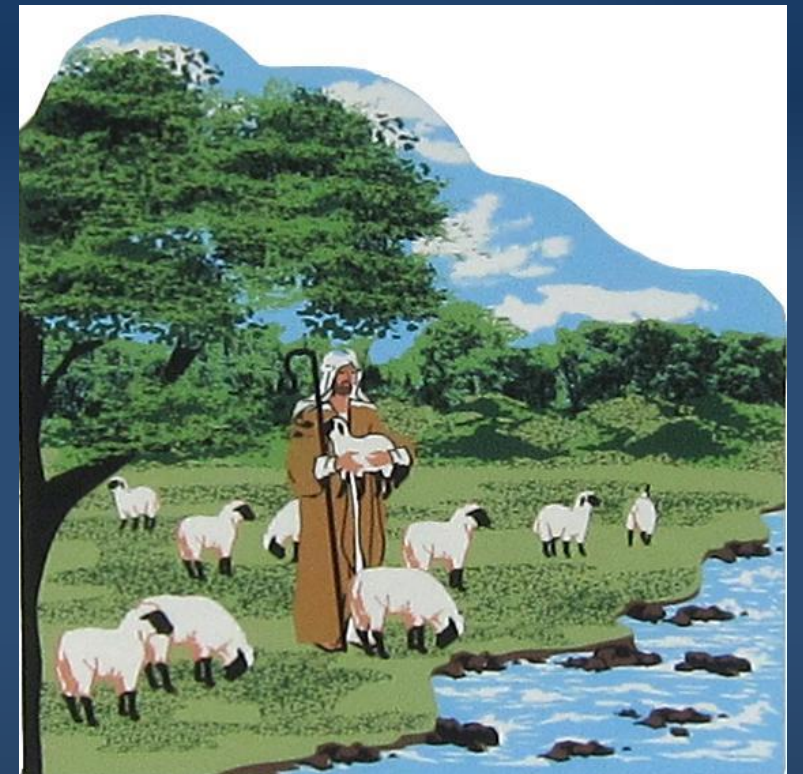
Tuesday 23rd June

I wonder if you could...Let's give ideas about what they could do.

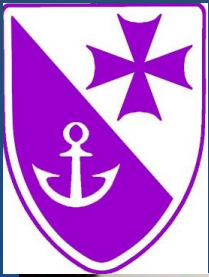
Be sure to ask how it is going tomorrow and through the week.



P4C activity about fear and confidence:

Leader:

- ▶ I met a monster on the way home last night and he asked if he could come to stay with us.
- ▶ **Family to decide with stand up sit down vote.**
- ▶ Make two groups-
- ▶ Those who said yes, those who said no.
- ▶ **Talk in own group then share with all. Give reasons.**
- ▶ What would be the good things and the bad things about having a monster at home?
