Mathsnificent Maths Challenge

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are launching an exciting new maths challenge called 'Mathsnificent'. It is aimed at helping your child learn their number facts and improve their number skills.

At home:

Your child will come home with a maths learning card. The card contains maths facts your child needs to learn. Please help your child practice these at home.

At School:

We will check what your child has learnt. We will award a Mathsnificent card every time they learn the facts on the learning card.

Your child can collect the cards and use them to play a Mathsnificent Card game. There are different cards to collect!

'Mathsnificent' cards:

There are three different levels of cards to collect.

-Monsters

-Heroes and Villains

-Fantastical

How to play Mathsnificent card game:

The goal of the Mathsnificent card game is to win the most cards by having the highest-scoring card in each round.

Instructions:

You will need your Mathsificent cards. Shuffle the cards and share them evenly among all players. Each player holds their cards facing down and the oldest player goes first. On their turn, a player selects a category from their top card e.g., speed, power. They tell all the players the score for that category. Other players then say the score from the same category from their cards.

The player with the highest value in that category wins the round and collects all the played cards. The player who won the round starts the next round by choosing a new category from their card.

Winning: The game continues until one player has all the cards. The player with the most cards at the end is the Mathsificent card game champion!
