Our EYFS curriculum is taught through four aspirations.

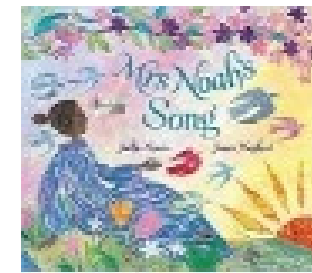
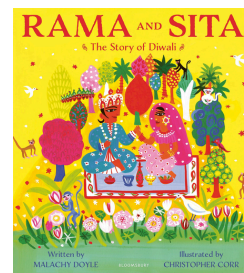
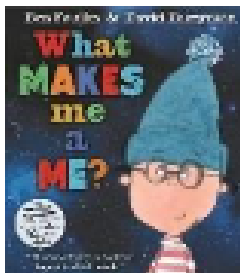
Create, explain and model how to play a game, inside or outside, using resources of their choice and articulate simple rules.

Grow an insect-friendly garden and talk about changes observed over time.

Choose a favourite story and retell in their own way to a small audience using props, costumes, music effects.

Know what makes a celebration special and work collaboratively to explore, plan, create and take part in a celebration.

Talk about books I love – developing a love of reading at school and at home

Share stories and have discussions about birthdays and other celebrations.

Join in role play, cooking and creating for a special occasion.

Talk about what I do and what you do to celebrate.

Hear stories about people in the community.

Meet visitors from the local community – find out what do they do to help us? What can we do to help?



Make Mini Mes

Use resources to be creative, and express myself in different ways – art, music, dance.

Learn action/clapping songs and rhyming games to play together.

Play large and small games, following the instructions/rules, sharing, taking turns, working together, including matching and dice games.

Learn how to tidy up and put away – making labels and taking photographs of our environment



A walk around school and the local area to notice landmarks and people.

Learn about my community, visit to church and taking part in Harvest Festival.

Look for seasonal changes in the secret garden– making collections and sorting natural loose parts, conkers, acorns. Noticing animals and plants in our secret garden. How can we help them – making a bug hotel, bird feeder etc.
