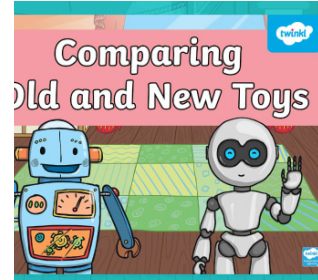


Little Oaks Curriculum Newsletter Autumn 2025

Reading we will explore



EAD

We will complete art and design activities through our Attention Autism program, 4 times per week. We will sing and learn to sign nursery rhymes every day.

My Favourite Toys

Literacy

We will explore stories and information books. We will learn key signs and symbols.

Understanding the World and Technology

We will talk about similarities and differences. We will compare toys from long ago and today. We will explore pushes and pulls. We will learn to take photographs using our iPads. We will begin to learn to click and drag and to play games in Busy Things.

Physical Development, PSED and Communication & Language

We will learn to walk safely at height, to jump and land safely. We will learn about different emotions. We will practise making marks on different surfaces.

Maths

We will sing number rhymes, match and sort objects and consider sizes and shapes.

RE

We will learn about religious celebrations from around the world and from the UK.
