Writing



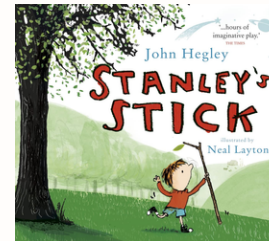
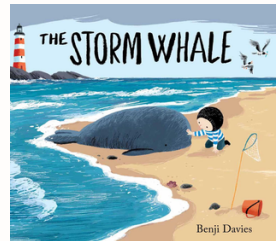
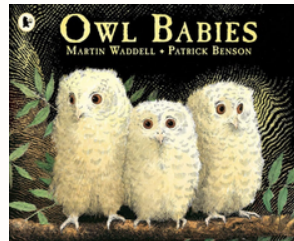
In writing we will practise our sentence writing. We will retell stories based on stories we know and create fact files about animals. We will continue to practise our letter formation of lower case and capital letters.

Reading

In reading we will continue to learn new sounds and use this knowledge to read unfamiliar words. We will learn to read new 'tricky' words. (see next page)

Music

In music we will learn about dynamics and tempo. We will use instruments and our voices to create sound.

Maths

In maths we will focus on place value, counting, sorting and comparing amounts. We will learn number bonds to 10 and practise adding and subtraction.

Computing

In science we will learn about different everyday materials and explore their properties.

PE

In PE we will explore dance skills and practise working as a team.
