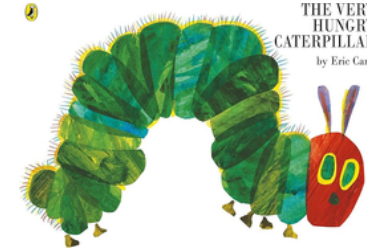
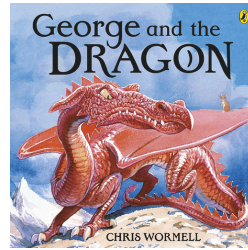


Reception Curriculum Newsletter Spring 2025
