Writing

In writing we will learn to use adjectives and conjunctions to extend our sentences and make our writing more interesting and engaging for the audience. We will also continue to practice our letter formation and will develop our use of punctuation.

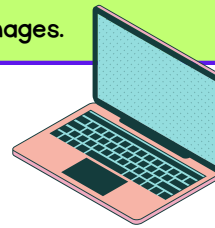
Reading

In reading we will continue to develop our fluency and independence in reading and will explore how punctuation influences how we read the text.



Computing

In Computing we will learn to create, save and retrieve images.



Maths

In Maths we will develop our understanding of numbers to 100 and will practice adding and subtracting two digit numbers. We will also explore 2D and 3D shapes.

Art

In Art we will explore tone and texture. We will use a range of mark making techniques to create different effects and add detail to our sketches.

Music

In Music we will explore the different types of sounds made by different instruments.



Geography

In Geography we will use atlases and globes to explore the location of the seven continents of the world and the world's five oceans.

History

In History we will learn about significant people that have explored the world such as Captain Cook.

PE

In PE we will continue to explore our fundamental moving skills including balancing, running, hopping, skipping and jumping. We will develop our techniques to make our movements strong and controlled.

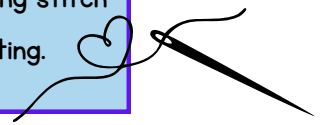
Science

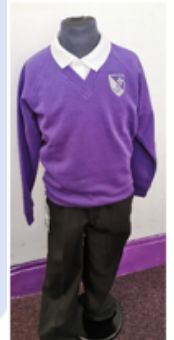

Uniform

- White Polo t-shirt
 - Grey or black trousers, skirts or dresses.
 - Purple jumper or cardigan (with logo)
 - White or black socks or tights
 - Black shoes
 - Optional - Purple gingham dresses or black/navy shorts (summer term until October half term)

- Purple polo t-shirt (with or without logo)
