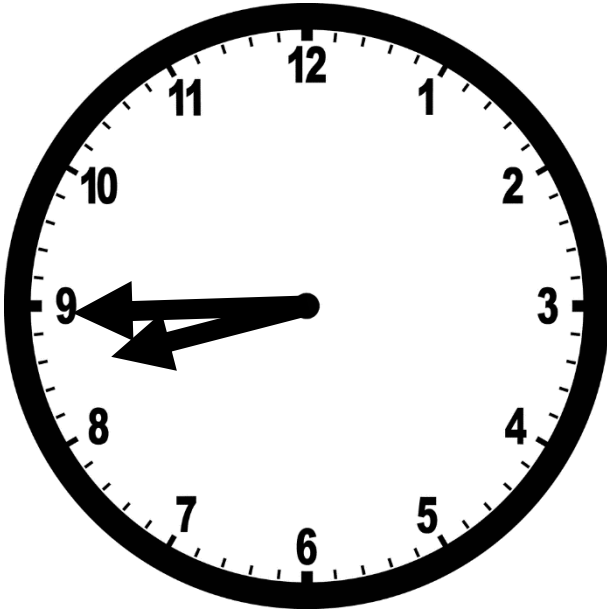

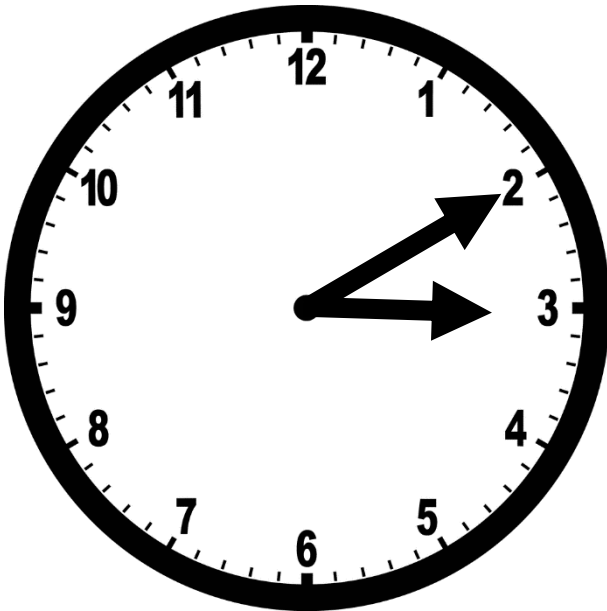
We understand there may be exceptional circumstances or special occasions when you need to absent your child from school. However, we are committed to improve attendance and to achieve the expected government attendance level of 96% and above for each child, therefore your child must attend school regularly. We must stress that unless we consider there is a very good reason for your child to be absent in term time a leave request will not be authorised.

If you do remove your child for an unauthorised absence you may be referred to the Education Social Worker, this can result in a Penalty Notice and fine (£80-£160 per parent/carer per child) being issued to you.
