

This leaflet highlights the 5-minute walking zone created by the School Council at St Clement's and St John's Infant School. Pupils took part in a walking activity to measure how far they could travel from the school in five minutes. This has informed the 5 minute Walking Zone on the map attached.

To help reduce congestion around the school, we encourage everyone who drives to park outside this zone and enjoy a short walk to the gates. This small change can make a big difference—improving safety, reducing air pollution, and giving children a healthy, active start to their day.



What the school councillors had to say about travelling actively to school and the walk we went on....

"Walking is calmer than going in a car and walking is more healthy."

"It's quite peaceful."

"There is more fresh air and you can breathe clean air.....you can hear the birds instead of the roaring car engines."

"You can hear the birds chirping."

"It's nice because I go over the bridge and sometimes I see the trains."

"It's a beautiful walk with lots of beautiful flowers."

If you do have to drive

- Try and 'Park and Stride' and walk, cycle or scoot the last 5-10 minutes.
- Be considerate and keep resident's driveways clear.
- Make sure there is enough space for an emergency vehicle to access the school.
- Car share where possible.
- Switch off your engine whilst stationary—help keep the air clean.
- Please don't park on the pavements or across drop curbs.



St Clement's and St John's Infant School Walking Zone Map

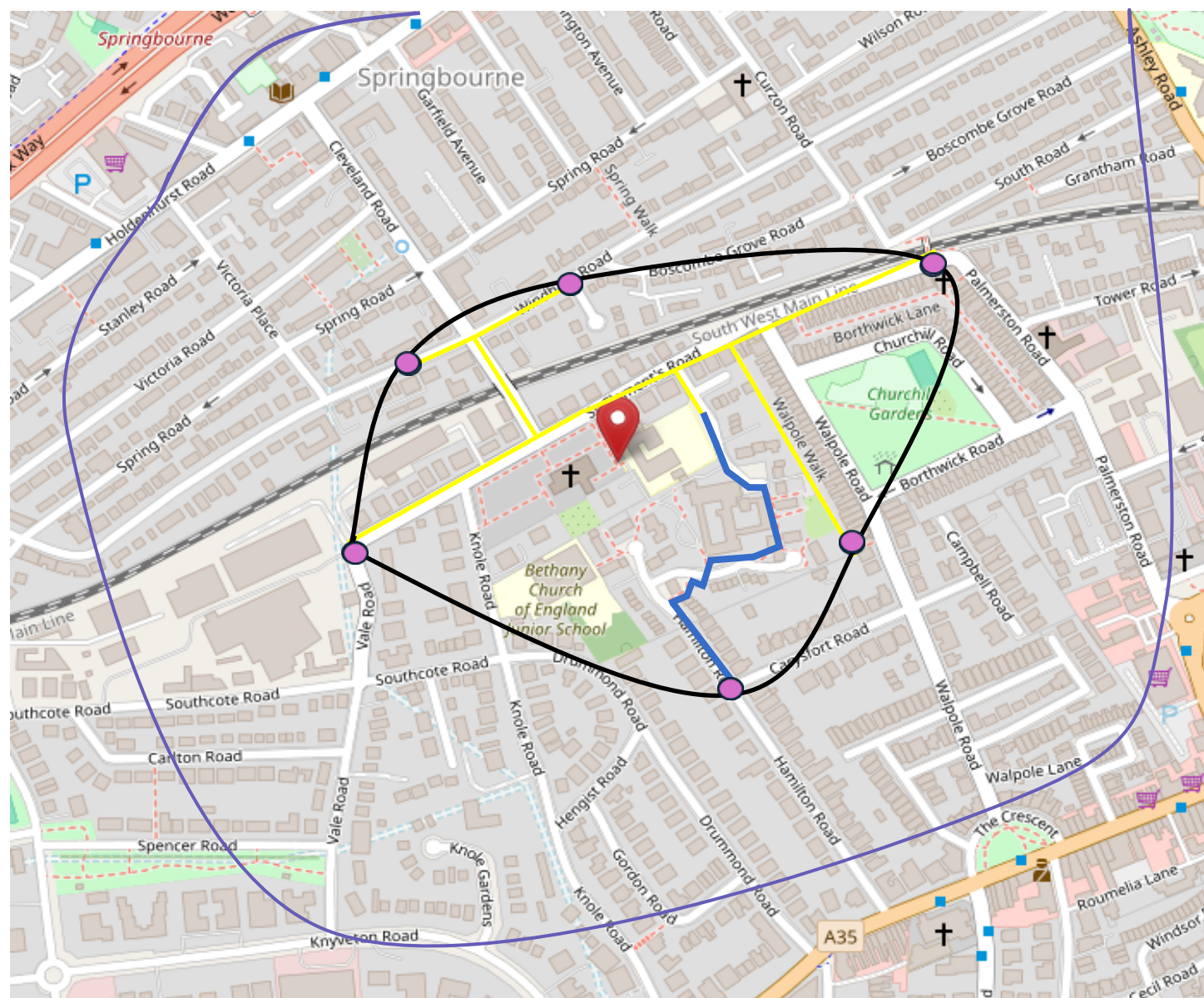


Our aim is to reduce traffic congestion around the school and encourage more families to walk at least part of their journey to school.
